MONTEREY RECREATION

Dear Parents of Day Campers:

We are excited that you registered your child for camp. Whispering Pines Day Camp is located in a secluded, natural area at 1085 Pacific Street near Alameda Street in Monterey. The City of Monterey Recreation operates this camp which has been in existence since 1955.

Our camp offers every child a unique experience and fosters appreciation for the great outdoors. The camp operates on a weekly basis for seven weeks. Friday's are usually the highlight of each week at camp because the children will cook their lunch and participate in the campfire program. **Camp is held Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 5:30pm.**

We believe in careful and close supervision of the children. Day Campers will be involved in hiking, singing, dancing, arts and crafts, as well as the basic skills necessary for camping. It is our hope that the Day Camp experience will be educational as well as fun-filled.

The camp staff and a well-planned camp curriculum are the most important aspect of our camp program. Each staff person is carefully selected and thoroughly trained to cope with any situation that might arise. Each counselor will have a group of children for whom they will directly be responsible.

<u>NOTE</u>: If you are <u>not</u> picking up your child, please notify us as to who has permission to pick up your child.

WE WOULD APPRECIATE YOUR COOPERATION IN THESE MAIN AREAS:

- 1. The gates will be opened each morning at 8:45am and opened again each evening at 5:15pm. Please do not arrive before these times for drop off or pick up. The gates will be closed. We ask that parents refrain from scheduling other appointments and classes for their child while they are at camp. Children miss activities and staff can't make-up the activity with your child because of our busy schedule.
- 2. Please label all of your child's extra clothing (jackets, hats, sweatshirts, etc.) with their names.
- 3. Please make sure you apply sunscreen in the morning before dropping your child at camp.
- 2. Each day, except Fridays, please send your child's lunch in a paper bag rather than in a lunch box. This makes it much easier for your child to carry their lunches on hikes. A snack and juice are served to the children daily. Please pack a water bottle with your child each day. Please feed your child a hearty breakfast and pack a substantial, healthy lunch each day so that they will have lots of energy for the day's activities.
- 3. When you bring your child to camp, plan on a short delay as we take time to assure safety for all our campers. Your patience while waiting will be appreciated. Please observe traffic regulations and drive slowly through camp. Following drop-off and pick-up instructions and times will help tremendously in getting cars in and out as quickly as possible. You cannot make a left turn into the Park or a left turn coming out of the Park. RIGHT TURNS ONLY. Please remember there is no stopping on Pacific Street or left hand turns into or out of the park. Also, please do not park in the Doctor's office parking lots as you may be ticketed or towed. Monterey Police Department will be routinely patrolling Pacific Street to enforce traffic regulations.

4. If your child requires emergency medication or epinephrine to accompany him or her, you will need to complete the Authorization for Emergency Medication form. This form must be on file with Monterey Recreation one week before your child's first day of camp. Please send all medication in the original package or bottle with specific directions for administration and dosage. Forms are available by email request at: montereyrecreation@monterey.gov

Each week we will stencil t-shirts for the children. If you would like your child to have a t-shirt stenciled, please send a white t-shirt labeled with your child's name on or before Thursday morning.

PARENTS/DRIVERS:

Please help us to avoid accidents and traffic violations by not making left hand turns in or out of the Day Camp driveway or stopping your vehicle on Pacific Street. In order to keep traffic from backing up on Pacific Street, please do not arrive for drop off any earlier than 8:45am or for pick up any earlier than 5:15pm. For camp safety, staff will not open the gates until this time. Camp is held Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 5:30pm. When making a right turn into the driveway, please loop around in the cul-de-sac first and then one of the Camp Directors will sign your child in or out. Then move your car into one of the first 3 positions, a Camp Staff Member will assist by opening the car door to greet your child. Do not let children out of the car until then. If anyone will be picking up your child other than yourself, please be sure to let us know who it will be on the morning prior. If you are walking or biking to camp, please enter camp from the left side of the driveway and stay on the unpaved mulch or grassy side of the park. This minimizes the conflicts between vehicles and pedestrians.
