Monterey Police Department (MPD) Highlights
September 2017

NARRATIVE

- The MPD is hosting a Citizens Police Academy, which meets for (11) weeks from 09-06-17 to 11-15-17. There are 25 attendees who are learning about various aspects of the criminal justice system and city government. The instructors are comprised of over forty various criminal justice and government professionals.
- The MPD has started a monthly meeting of first line supervisors from various departments throughout the city to discuss and address quality of life issues that affect Monterey.
- MPD personnel are participating in the “Pink Patch Project” during the month of October to raise awareness and funds to assist in the fight against cancer.
- An MPD officer worked with Monterey Sports Center employees to identify and arrest a suspect who was responsible for thefts from the Sports Center and another local gym.
- An MPD officer’s thorough investigation led to the arrest of a suspect for numerous burglary and counterfeiting charges.
- PRVNT arrested seven gang members in various cities on the Peninsula and Salinas for felons in possession of firearms and gang enhancements.

Table A – August 2016 v. August 2017

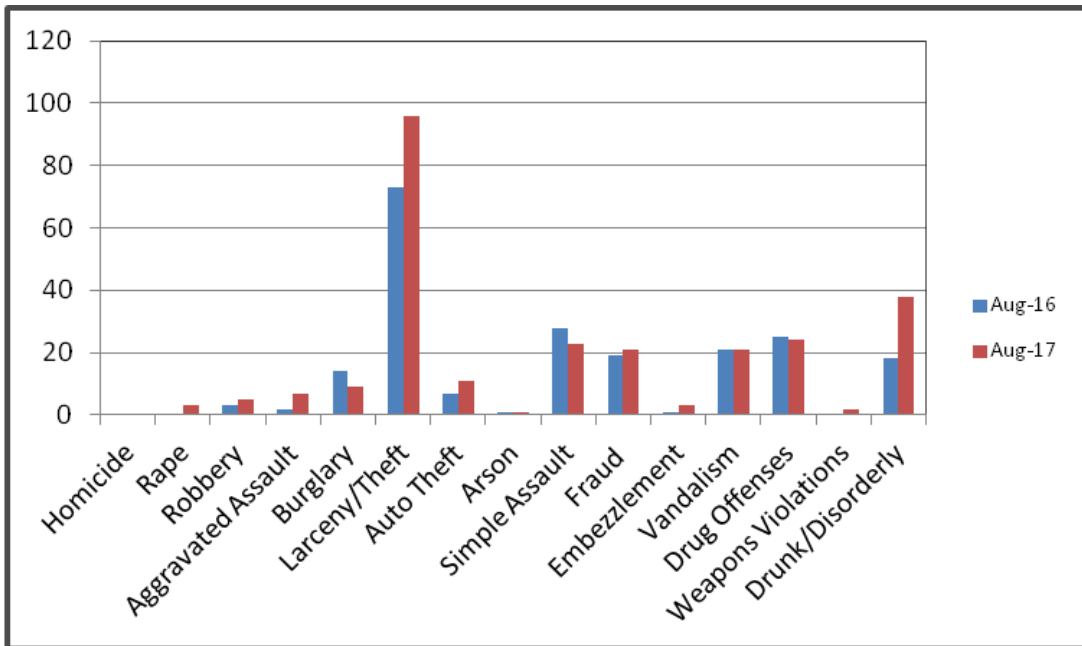


Table B – 2016 Monthly Average v. August 2017
