

## What kind of messages will I receive?

Alert Monterey County messages pertain to the safety, health, or welfare of the community affected by a potential or an actual emergency. Evacuation, shelter-in-place, re-entry notifications, public health advisories, recommended protective measures and incident situation information alerts are typical. You have the ability to choose how you want notifications sent to you at the time of registration. The telephone number you register will only be called when the address/zip code you provide may be impacted by an emergency situation. You **will not** receive advertising or other non-emergency notifications through Alert Monterey County.

## Who manages Alert Monterey County?

The Alert Monterey County system is managed by the Monterey County Department of Emergency Management, in partnership with all city public safety agencies in Monterey County as well as California State University Monterey Bay.

## What is Alert Monterey County?

Alert Monterey County is the system used by city and county public safety officials to deliver emergency notifications and information to residents and businesses impacted by, or in danger of being impacted by an emergency or disaster.

## How does Alert Monterey County work?

Alert Monterey County uses information from **Alert Monterey County Registrations**, 9-1-1 and utilities databases, as well as other sources to send emergency notifications via **voice phone calls, text/SMS messages, and TTY** to a **geographic area** selected by public safety and emergency management professionals in Monterey County.



## Who has access to my information?

Only authorized and trained public safety officials from Monterey County and your local city are allowed to send alerts through the system.

## Is there a charge for this service?

There is no charge for registering, or for receiving these messages, however your cellular data and messaging rates will apply.

- Physical address or addresses in Monterey County
