RESIDENT PARKING PROGRAM TOWN HALL: IMPROVING RESIDENTIAL PARKING IN 2025

Monterey, Calif. – The City of Monterey Parking Division is working on updating the Residential Parking Program to make parking in neighborhoods more efficient, easier, and more accessible for residents. A Resident Parking Program Town Hall is scheduled for Thursday, March 27 at 5:30 p.m. in the Monterey Council Chamber, Few Memorial Hall, located at 580 Pacific Street in Monterey.

Parking Superintendent Cristie Steffy said, “We look forward to introducing a modernized residential parking permit program, designed to provide our residents with more convenience and flexibility. A new online platform will be launched soon to make it simple for residents to manage their permits from home, eliminating the need for in-person office visits and saving valuable time. We encourage residents to come to the Town Hall and tell us what they want to see in a resident parking program and to learn more about this new online system.”
